WHEREAS, Glenn P Shores and Patti J Shores have filed an application for a Subdivision and Land Development in Wysox Township with the Bradford County Planning Commission (Subdivision File No. 2016-127) for the property known as Shores Sisters Market:

I move that the Wysox Board of Supervisors agree to be a co-applicant for a permit from Pennsylvania Department of Transportation with Glenn P. Shores and Patti J. Shores for the water retention discharge into the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation storm drainage system on US Route 6 which fronts the Shores Sisters property. This agreement to be a co-applicant will be contingent upon the following:

- Township to reimburse the Township for any future maintenance required to be performed by the Township with regard to the water retention system. Said agreement will be prepared by the Township solicitor and will be mutually agreed upon by both parties, before the permit application is submitted to Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
- 2) That the Shores Sisters receive an approval from the Bradford County Planning Commission for the land development application.
- That the water retention system is placed underground. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Wysox, that effective this $\frac{\int \frac{1}{2} d}{\int dx}$ day of April, 2017, the foregoing Resolution is adopted.
