

**TOWNSHIP OF WYSOX,
BRADFORD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

A RESOLUTION NO. __03 OF 2020

WHEREAS, The Township Supervisors of the Township of Wysox, Bradford County, Pennsylvania (the “Township”) officially, recognizes the fire company organization known as “Wysox Volunteer Fire Company” (the “Fire Company”); and

WHEREAS, The Township Supervisors of the Township of Wysox previously authorized the Fire Company to perform functions of the Fire Company including fighting fires, performing rescues, participating in fund raising activities, participating in training exercises and training competition in fire related activities.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) has affected many people and organizations throughout the world and within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, causing a public health emergency situation.

WHEREAS, The Fire Company has qualified and capable ambulance drivers to operate emergency vehicles to transport, Coronavirus (COVID-19) victims as well as other patients in need of medical transportation services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WYSOX, BRADFORD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREFORE, The President of the United States, Donald Trump, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Tom Wolf, the Bradford County Commissioners, and the Township Supervisors of Wysox have declared a State of Emergency due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.


WHEREFORE, The Supervisors of Wysox Township agree to authorize the Fire Company as part of their Fire Company duties covered by the Worker’s Compensation Insurance Carrier to serve as volunteers providing medical transportation services for Coronavirus (COVID-19) patients and other patients in need of medical care and treatment.

WHEREFORE, The Fire Company volunteers with Emergency Vehicle Operations (EVO) Class License can operate emergency vehicles for medical transfer. This shall be due to the current Coronavirus (COVID-19) epidemic and it’s duration. In addition the Supervisors of Wysox Township agree that this authorization shall be permitted on such other occasions, beyond the current State of Emergency, when it becomes necessary to operate Medical Transport Vehicle and provide medical transportation services due to the unavailability of the commercial ambulance driver.




