## **September Township Manager Business:**

1. Called Jennifer Means at DEP for update on Shale Rail Dust issue – still no solid answers
2. Called PA DOT on info on Sawmill Road turn back for O’Reilly – they haven’t found anything. Due to Covid, limited research can be done.
3. Lou Aquillio was in very concerned about his neighbor’s encroachment (Control Tech) Mike Niemic helped handle the problem
4. Called on 811 fees. Free to homeowners of population of township under 2000 people commercial fee is \$125 per year
5. Talked to Spv Thompson. He was going to reach out to owner of Reeves Industrial Park on Silica sand issue.
6. Attended PA DOT meeting concerning options at Rt 6 and Rt 187. Zoom meeting – Little turnout. Wysox Township offered building for people to view and respond.
7. Attended Progress authority meeting
8. Followed up on traffic light issues at both Bradford Plaza and Craftmaster Intersection
9. PA DOT called township to follow up on any comments on RT6 and Rt 187 meeting
