MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

October 12, 2022

Supervisor Thompson moved to approve the minutes of the previous regular meeting held on September 14, 2022 Supervisor Gannon seconded and motion carried with 3 ayes.

2. Security Cameras for boat launch- waiting on a contract proposal from Rural Net lawyer.

Under New Business:

1. The township is sending a letter to PennDot requesting a traffic study to see if the intersection at Rt 6 and Lanning Creek Road qualifies for a red light.
2. Supervisor Thompson moved to approve the Kulick, and Kulick/Costello subdivisions. Supervisor Gannon seconded; motion carried with 3 ayes

3. Supervisor Gannon moved to approved John Stackpole to replace Terri McGarrity on Progress Authority Board. Supervisor Them seconded; Supervisor Thompson abstained. Motion carried with 2 ayes.
4. Parking on Pringle Lane was discussed and whether on street parking will be allowed and if so on which side of the street. The topic was tabled for further consideration.
5. Wysox Fire Department has asked the township to take over mowing of the fire department lawns. Jon Kulick will get an estimate of how much it will cost to hire out the mowing of the lawn at the fire department and pass that estimate along to the fire department. The fire department is its own entity. Therefore, the lawn is the responsibility of the fire department.

Supervisor Thompson moved to adjourned the meeting at 5:20, Supervisor Gannon seconded, 3 ayes.
