Supervisor Thompson moved to approve the minutes of the previous regular meeting held on August 9, 2023. Supervisor Gannon seconded and motion carried with 3 ayes.

Solicitor report— Attorney Chris Jones is still working with Eric Casanave from Stiffler McGraw on the curb cut ordinance.

2. Supervisor Thompson motioned to approve the Wheeler subdivision Supervisor Gannon seconded and motion carried with 3 ayes.

- 3. Supervisor Gannon motioned to approve the Fire Service agreement which states that the Wysox Fire Department covers all Wysox Township. Supervisor Thompson seconded. Motion carried with 3 ayes.
- 4. Supervisor Thompson motioned to approve change order No. 1 from Sikora Brothers Paving, for extending sump pump discharge pipe at 60 East St., in the amount of \$1200.00 and that the money is to be paid from the Capital Reserve Account for Roads, Buildings, and Equipment. Supervisor Gannon seconded and motion carried with 3 ayes.
- 5. Supervisor Gannon motioned to approve payment application No. 3 from Sikora Brothers Paving in the amount of \$142,843.52 being paid from the Township's project PA DOT funding account and \$1,425.00 being paid from the Capital Reserve Account for Roads, Buildings, and Equipment. Supervisor Thompson seconded and motion carried with 3 ayes.
- 6. Supervisor Thompson motioned to approve the proposed contract between Wysox Township and S&A Construction prepared by Solicitor Chris Jones for the work needed to correct the driveway issues at 71 Pennsylvania Ave and 89 Pennsylvania Ave, and that the money is to be paid from the Capital Reserve Account for roads, buildings, and equipment. The contract is to be signed by the chairman of the Board of Supervisors and attested by the Secretary. This motion is contingent upon Scott Schmeckenbecker from S&A Construction signing the contract and also signed an invoice proposal which was amended by Eric Cassanave from Stiffler McGraw to be identified to as Exhibit A of the contract. Supervisor Gannon seconded and motion carried with 3 ayes.
- 7. Supervisor Gannon motioned that when the reimbursement money agreed upon by Stiffler McGraw and Sikora Brothers is received by the Township, that is returned to the Capital Reserve Account for Roads, Buildings, and Equipment.
